

# A-113 ELECTIVES

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## DIGITAL ART

The course will focus on a variety of software tools, design strategies and photo production to create both commercial and fine art projects.

**Prerequisites:** none. Any student may take the Digital Art class including current Visual Art students.

**The course will include:**

- **Photoshop Design:** Designing with Photoshop, the latest professional graphics software
- **Digital Photography:** Learning the basics of DSLR cameras to create art and visual stories
- **3-D Sculpture:** Creating character design with clay and 3-D software
- **Collage Painting:** Using watercolor and collage materials to create movie poster design
- **Watercolor Design:** Designing characters for comic books
- **Digital Animation:** Creating animated projects using digital software
- **Garage Band Software / Synthesizers:** Basic music and sound design

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## Advanced Digital Art & Photography (Honors)

This course will focus on the photo image using advanced camera work, photo manipulation, working with mixed-media in the student's journal and on the computer.

**Prerequisites:** A-113 Visual Art Students with an "A" may enroll. Digital Art students with an "A" or "B" may enroll. *Additional students with an approved portfolio may also enroll.*

**This course will include:**

- **Digital Photography:** Creating a portfolio of DSLR photography, enhanced with software
- **Photoshop Photomontage:** Creating collage work using found and created photo images.
- **Collage Painting:** Designing ideation mixed-media collages
- **Digital Filmmaking:** Producing a group film project using only still images.
- **Student Design:** Design projects using a variety of media ideas and concerns
- **Digital Portfolio:** Create a portfolio of work similar to AP 2-D Design.

The Anime Club will show films, fundraise for the Anime Expo coming in July, host anime drawing classes, contests and shows and promote field trips to Little Tokyo and the Japanese American Museum. *All students are welcome.*

Eight students from A-113 Visual Art will be chosen to participate in college-prep sketchbook assignments, pushing these students towards advanced courses such as AP Studio and Design. *Three additional students may apply as well.*
